

The clamp touches or comes close to the top of the light and makes it impossible to tip out or remove. Use this mounting option if you do not plan to use the light in a portable manner.






We recommend testing your new Whitening Crystal Arm with an assistant before using it with a patient. This will help you become familiar with the movements of the Whitening Crystal Arm.

Use a combination of chair adjustments with articulating arm adjustments when positioning your patient next to the Whitening Crystal Arm.




Note: The **Sapphire Light** Mounting Bracket is preassembled eighteen inches below the top of the post. When adjusting this bracket use the 1/4" hex key provided.




1. Using your fingers or the 10 mm hex key, remove the hex bolt and base washer from the bottom of the post.




2. Firmly place the post into the caster base.





5. The torque on the joints of the **Whitening Crystal Arm** may be tightened or loosened with the 5/32" and 3/16" hex keys.



NOTE: These joints are preadjusted at the factory for proper operation.
